## Purpose



• Allow multinational agencies, regardless of their language, to exchange information by searching multilingual databases.





## Challenges



- Language Barriers
  - Three languages spoken among countries
  - Different dialects spoken
  - Glossary of terms
- Internet Access
  - Most Latin American countries have slow internet access
  - Access to large databases using a phone line is slow making a system ineffective.





#### Research Goals



• Develop methods for multinational agencies in a domain specific area to effectively exchange information in a timely manner regardless of language





### **Tasks**



- Structure unstructured documents (metadata)
- Text analysis
- Keyword weighting techniques
- Generating and maintaining thesauri
- Classifying queries (metadata)





### Current and future status

- Will prototype system in two or three countries including the US
